The Church was founded in 1972 as Holy Trinity Anglican Church and is located in Redmond, Washington. They were always independent and never part of the Episcopal Church in the USA. On April 30, 2003, Bishop J. Gérard A. LaPlante accepted the request of the vestry and Fr. Gary Wulf to be their Bishop and since then Holy Trinity is in full communion with the Old Catholic Church of BC. On March 29, 2017 the name was changed to Holy Trinity Old Catholic Church.
