The Reverend Father Dana Mark Updegrove

The Rev. Fr. Dana was born in Pennsylvania and grew up in the Midwest. After High School graduation in Houston, Texas he joined his family in Idaho where he took his first studies. He worked for the aerospace industry as a mathematician and engineer, and became a teacher and then professor in his field. His interest for the faith led him to study theology. Fr. Dana received several degrees, a Bachelor of Science in 1977 from Idaho State University, a Master of Science in Mathematics in 1979 from the University of Tennessee, a Master of Divinity from Golden Gate Baptist Theological Seminary in 1987, and a Master of Arts in Philosophy from the University of Mississippi in 2008. He is a full-time professor of Mathematics and Philosophy at Bellevue Community College since 1991.

Deacon Jean Doucet was born in Bathurst, New Brunswick, where most of his family still live. He is Acadian and speaks French and English. The Doucet family has a long time connection with Bishop Gérard LaPlante and the Old Catholic Church of BC going back to his brother Patrick Doucet, who came to Vancouver in 1978. 
