

# The Old Catholic Church of British in Columbia in Québec province Old Catholic Mission Québec City—Fr. Claude Lacroix

Since February 2000 the Old Catholic Church of BC has representation in the province of Québec. First was Father Sylvain Tremblay, who was ordained on 6 February 2000 by Bishop Gérard LaPlante, then on November 20, 2004 Fr. Claude Lacroix joined us, and finally in November 2006 Fr. Daniel Du-lude. Since May 2007 the Old Catholic Mission in Québec rents the Anglican Church St. James in Lac Beauport (close to Québec City) for their Sunday Holy Mass and other sacraments. In July 2007 the Québec government granted the Old Catholic Church of BC the right to officiate at weddings.
